## DATA ENTRY AND CHANGES TO YOUR INFORMATION

Data entry mistakes happen. That is why we ask everyone to READ their preliminary confirmation and mailed final confirmation. For the majority of entries, dog and owner/handler information remains the same. However, if you have a:

New email address

New Title/sNew Handler

New address and phone

New jump height

(including jump height changes from trial to trial. For example, dog jumps 24" at one trial, then 26" in the next trial.)

Highlighting ANY of these changes on entry forms would be especially helpful so that these changes can be updated in our database. Then, please review your confirmations carefully to ensure that your requested changes have been made

**REFUNDS:** There shall be **no refunds for entries withdrawn in the event a dog and/or handler are injured, absent, or dismissed from competition,** regardless of the reason for such dismissal. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of management it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. Refunds are allowed if requested before the closing date. Refunds after closing date for bitches in season only. A \$5.00 processing fee for ANY refunds.

**BITCHES IN SEASON** are not eligible to participate. Entry fees will be refunded subject to a \$5.00 processing fee. Written verification from a veterinarian is required. **Notification for refund of bitches in season must be RECEIVED no later than 48 hrs after end of the trial. ## **ABOUT EMAILED CORRESPONDENCE AND MOVEUPS**

Emails sent to us regarding move-ups, cancellations, etc will be addressed on a priority basis. All correspondence will be processed within one week of receipt; however, those emails that pertain to the current trial will be processed before emails regarding trials that are scheduled for a later date.

**We always send a reply email to all emailed cancellation requests when they are processed. We always send a reply email with a revised confirmation attached to all emailed moveup requests when they are processed.**

***If a response is NOT received before the above deadlines, please email it again and also send a backup fax request. Only call me if the emailed and faxed requests do not get a timely reply. Cancellation and changes to class (except moveups) deadline is **trial closing date and time (see premium)**. Please remember that Fast Times and the club are not responsible for emails that do not get delivered and therefore will not cancel an entry after the closing date and time or make a moveup after the moveup deadline due to non delivery of an email request

## **HEIGHT CARDS and MEASURING**

**1. If you did not include your height card WITH the entry then you will need to arrive early in order to show your height card or measurement slip or be measured.**

**2. ALL dogs without valid height cards need to arrive early in order to show their height cards or be measured to receive armbands.**

3. Check-in is available in the morning and will be done again for a short period before the second novice class of the day. These are the only designated times to show height cards and to be measured for the trial.

**4. Showing your card or getting measured MUST BE DONE DURING THESE TWO PERIODS.** It will not be done at other times.

Please see the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for current class descriptions. Dogs must be entered only in Regular Classes or Preferred Classes with no crossover between them allowed at the same set of trials.

## HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners/Agents are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. All height divisions will be offered in both the standard classes and the jumpers with weaves classes.

**Regular** Exhibitors may choose to enter their dog in a higher height division than required by AKC, but not in a height division lower than the AKC mandated height

**Preferred** The following jump heights **must** be used in all Preferred Classes.

	REGULAR	PREFERRED
Dogs 11 inches and under at the withers	8 inches	4 inches
Dogs 14 inches and under at the withers	12 inches	8 inches
Dogs 18 inches and under at the withers	16 inches	12 inches
Dogs 22 inches and under at the withers	20 inches	16 inches
Dogs over 22 inches	24 inches	20 inches

Dogs may be entered at 26" height at their owner's discretion.

## MEASURING and HEIGHT CARDS

YOU SHOULD ATTACH a copy of height card with EACH and EVERY ENTRY. Cards are not allowed to be kept on file

If you have never been measured for a permanent AKC jump height card, you can still enter any AKC Agility Trial. Your confirmation letter will indicate if there will be a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO). If so, this person will measure your dog. All jump heights MUST be measured unless you have a valid height card. If you do have a permanent jump height card from the AKC, you must send in a copy with your entry form. For more details:

If there is no official measurer at the trial, you will be measured by the judge for that weekend only. If there isn't a VMO present and your dog jumps 24", you will not need to be measured for the weekend. You will still need to be measured officially at some point.

If your dog measures lower during the weekend, you cannot move your dog down in jump height for that trial unless it is entered in the Preferred class. If your dog measures higher than the class you originally entered, you must notify Fast Times and show your dog in the higher jump height for that weekend and subsequent shows.

FAST TIMES WILL ACCEPT PHOTOCOPIES OF THE PERMANENT OR UNEXPIRED TEMPORARY HEIGHT CARD WITH THE ENTRY FOR THIS SHOW.

## **\*\*TRIAL REGULATIONS NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS \*\***

**THE TRIAL** will be open FRIDAY 11:00 am to 7pm and SAT /Sun 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.  
**RETURNED CHECKS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check.

**FAX, TELEPHONE AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES** cannot be accepted.

**ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS OR PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS** without the Agreement and Rules attached to the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE.**

**ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES** will not be accepted.

**NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.**

**WALKTHRUS.** No umbrellas allowed during walkthrus.

**JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS.** The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

**TRIAL COMMITTEE** will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

**DOGS** This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC, ILP or PAL number". (*Effective Feb 1, 2008.* )Dogs must be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Dogs under 6 months of age are not permitted on show grounds. Aggressive Dogs not permitted on site.

**DOGS MAY ARRIVE** any time prior to Judging, if a copy of their jump height card was sent with their entry. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring before their class begins.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

**MOVEUP DEADLINES:** Move-ups prior to a set of trials: Dogs can be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary not later than **6 pm on the Monday** preceding the set of trials for trials starting on a Thursday-Sunday. For trials that start on Monday-Wednesday, move-ups preceding the set of trials shall be accepted if received by the Trial Secretary no later than seven (7) days prior to the trial (i.e., for a Tuesday trial move-up requests must be made prior to 6 pm on the previous Tuesday).

For any moveups for a set of back-to-back agility trials held Thursday-Sunday: The 6 pm moveup deadline applies to the first day the dog is entered in a set of back-to-back agility trials.

For example, if it is a three-day set of back-to-back agility trials (Friday, Saturday, and Sunday) and the dog is entered on Saturday and Sunday, then a moveup for Saturday must be submitted by 6 pm on the Monday preceding the set of back-to-back agility trials.

Another example, if the dog is entered on Sunday only of a Saturday and Sunday set of back-to-back agility trials; the moveup deadline is still 6 pm on the Monday preceding the set of back-to-back agility trials. That Sunday only entry moveup is NOT considered a Day-to-Day moveup and therefore must be made by 6 pm on the preceding Monday. Once the 6 pm deadline has been reached the only moveups that will be allowed are Day-to-Day moveups as specified under Day-to-Day moveups.

**NOVICE MOVEUPS:** Dogs having attained their first AKC Agility Title (Std, JWW OR FAST) must be moved to the Nov B Class (Std, JWW and FAST) for all trials that have not reached the closing date. Once a trial closing date has past, a dog cannot be moved from Nov A to Nov B. If the trial has already reached the closing date on the day the dog obtained its title, the dog shall remain in the class in which it was originally entered. The dog can also be moved up a level (Nov to Open) at the request of the owner subject to the normal move-up criteria.

**DAY-TO-DAY MOVEUPS** are only allowed for dogs entered at the set of back-to-back agility trials for the dogs' succeeding days entries of that set of back-to-back agility trials and must be submitted in writing at the trial within ½ hour of the last run of the trial day for the following day(s) and can not be conveyed via fax, email, or verbally to the trial secretary.
